1. ELECTION

An Election is to be held of ONE Councillor for the above Town Council.

2. NOMINATION PAPERS

Nomination Papers may be obtained from the offices of the Returning Officer, Council Offices, Market Street, Newbury, RG14 5LD, Monday to Thursday 9am to 5pm and Friday 9am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays), who will at the request of any elector for the Town prepare a nomination paper for signature.

Alternatively, Nomination Papers may also be obtained from Mrs J. Collins, Town Clerk, The Library, Church Street, Hungerford, RG17 0JG.

3. DELIVERY OF THE NOMINATION PAPERS

Nomination Papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Council Offices, Market Street, Newbury, RG14 5LD, on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Thursday 9am to 5pm and Friday 9am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays), but not later than NOON on FRIDAY, 6TH MARCH 2009.

4. POLL

If the election is contested, a poll will take place on THURSDAY, 2ND APRIL 2009.

5. ABSENT VOTES

Electors and their proxies should take note that applications to vote by post must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on WEDNESDAY, 18TH MARCH 2009 if they are to be effective for this election. This includes electors or their proxies who wish to make alterations to their existing arrangements on a permanent basis or who wish to make separate application for their ballot paper to be sent to a different address for this particular election. Applications to appoint a proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by no later than 5pm on WEDNESDAY, 25TH MARCH 2009 except in cases where unforeseen illness or incapacity occurs after that time in which case applications may be made up until 5pm on THURSDAY, 2ND APRIL 2009. All applications and notices regarding absent voting must be sent to the Electoral Registration Officer, Council Offices, Market Street, Newbury, RG14 5LD
